

5-Year Management Plan Goal


 To improve physical habitat for sport fishes by diversifying and establishing self-sustaining native aquatic macrophyte communities while helping to prevent the spread of nuisance exotic plants.



5-Year Management Plan 2021-2026

- Defining success criteria
- Maintain existing exclosures and planted areas
- Identify additional areas (provide competition with Lyngbya)
- Managing Hydrilla in exclosures
- Explore new techniques for establishing vegetation
 - NCSU integrated fish attractor
- Monitoring
 - Annual end of growing season monitoring
 - Quantifying spread outside exclosures using drones every 5 years
